For golf fans, *The Masters* is awesome! It is easy to 'get into' the tournament and get excited about a favorite player or a story line. Yet this can't even compare with how we enter in to Holy Week. Please join us for the Triduum liturgies this week in which we enter in to the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ to eternal life. Bring your sorrows, your crosses, your joys too, and unite your life with the Paschal Mystery.

Even if you don't have a role in the liturgies, we are all called to actively participate. This goes far deeper than cheering for the golf tournament! Spiritually we enter in to the prayer, actively engaging the liturgy, putting all of our energy, our whole life into this solemn event.

This is what Lent has prepared us for, actively entering into the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ to eternal life, which is made present in the Sacred Triduum. By intentionally allowing the mystery to permeate our entire life, we become much more than fans on the sideline!
